## This funding will be used to:


- Ensure ALL students are achieving year level appropriate reading expectations.
- Provide additional support for students with identified areas of need.
- Utilise data coach to support & guide STLaN to access and document data sets.
- Develop ICPs for every student accessing a different year level curriculum.
- Maintain contact with U2B students (TDQs process) and monitor progress.
- Purchase additional testing tools (Salford Sentence Reading Test – Acer)

## Our initiatives include

- Employment of experienced teacher to take on a learning support role.
- Utilise additional resource/s to work with identified students.
- Implement diagnostic assessment plan and document on OS.
- Utilise expertise of regional T&L and HOC to provide feedback and specific instructional support

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ STLaN .1 to provide learning support via 1:1 and small group focussed, explicit instruction.
- Build staff capacity around text dependent questioning along with creative and critical thinking.
- Monitor through fortnightly staff meeting/weekly discourse and feedback.
- Funding distributed: \$5000 – TRS, Learning support, CCT.  
\$1440 – additional resources, programs, diagnostics.
